State Funeral of Her Majesty, Queen Elizabeth II

HAUC England pays its respects to Her Majesty the Queen for her unwavering and lifelong service to the United Kingdom and our thoughts and prayers are with the Royal Family at this most difficult of times.

The funeral of Her Majesty The Queen, will take place on Monday, 19 September 2022 at 11am in Westminster Abbey, London.

There is no obligation on organisations to suspend road and street works during the National Mourning period. Depending on the nature and location of their works, some works promoters may wish to consider closing or postponing works, especially on the day of the State Funeral, however this is at the discretion of individual organisation. Further guidance on any potential considerations relating to the day of the State Funeral will be issued by Central Government if needed.

Whilst there are no requirements to defer/cancel planned works on the day of the funeral, HAUC(England) ask as a mark of respect that any road or street works being carried out be suspended at 11am for the duration of the service.

There may be requests to expedite works around Westminster, the Royal Parks and the procession route to Windsor. These should be actioned wherever possible. Please be aware of any local instructions that may arise as a result of local thanksgiving events across the weekend and bank holiday.
